<u>Musical Skit</u> - Students demonstrated that mathematics permeates the world around us (Grades 1-3)

<u>Number a day Activity - Students did fun number sense activity. It was an enrichment activity, a fun math activity for building number sense.</u>

<u>Scavenger Hunt</u>-Students demonstrated mathematical thinking with real world examples. They were challenged to see who can find the most items from a list. The list had variety of basic math concepts such as counting, shapes, numbers or fractions, as seen in everyday components of the real world.




INTERNATIONAL FOOD WEEK CELEBRATION

Grade - 3 had an activity of relishing crunchy apples which goes with the proverb - An apple a day keeps the doctor away.














MORNING ASSEMBLIES
