

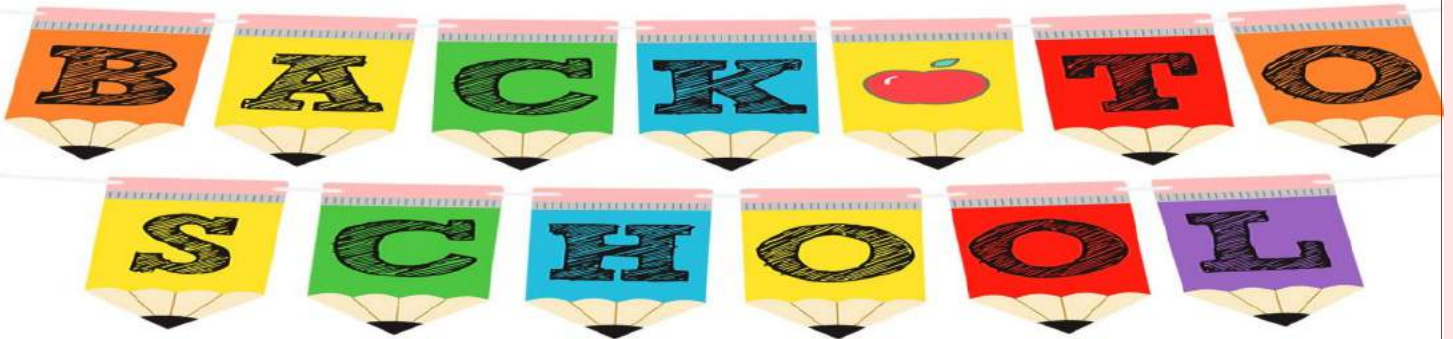

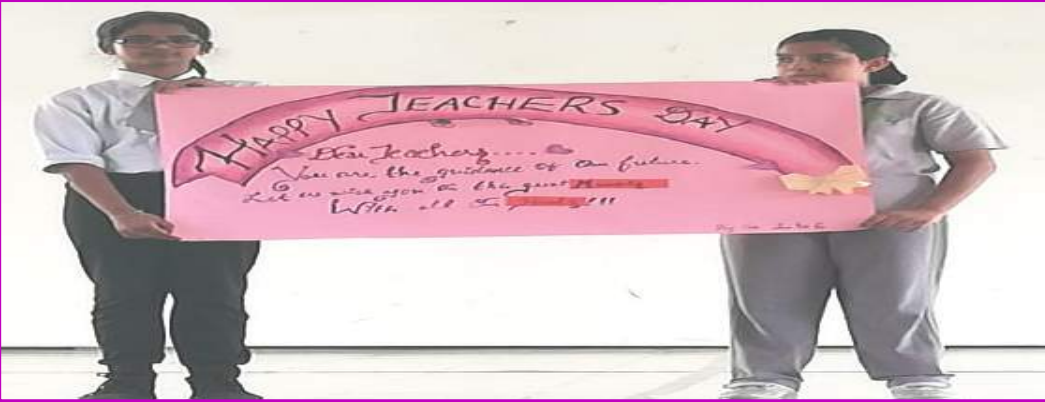
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# Teachers' Day Celebrations

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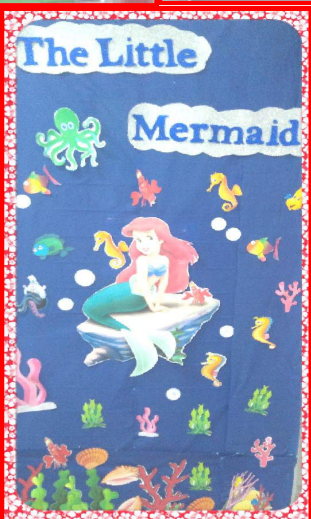
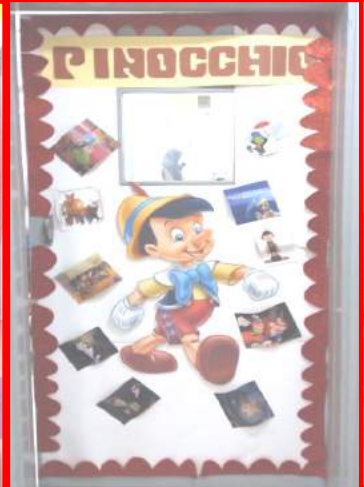
# Best out of Waste

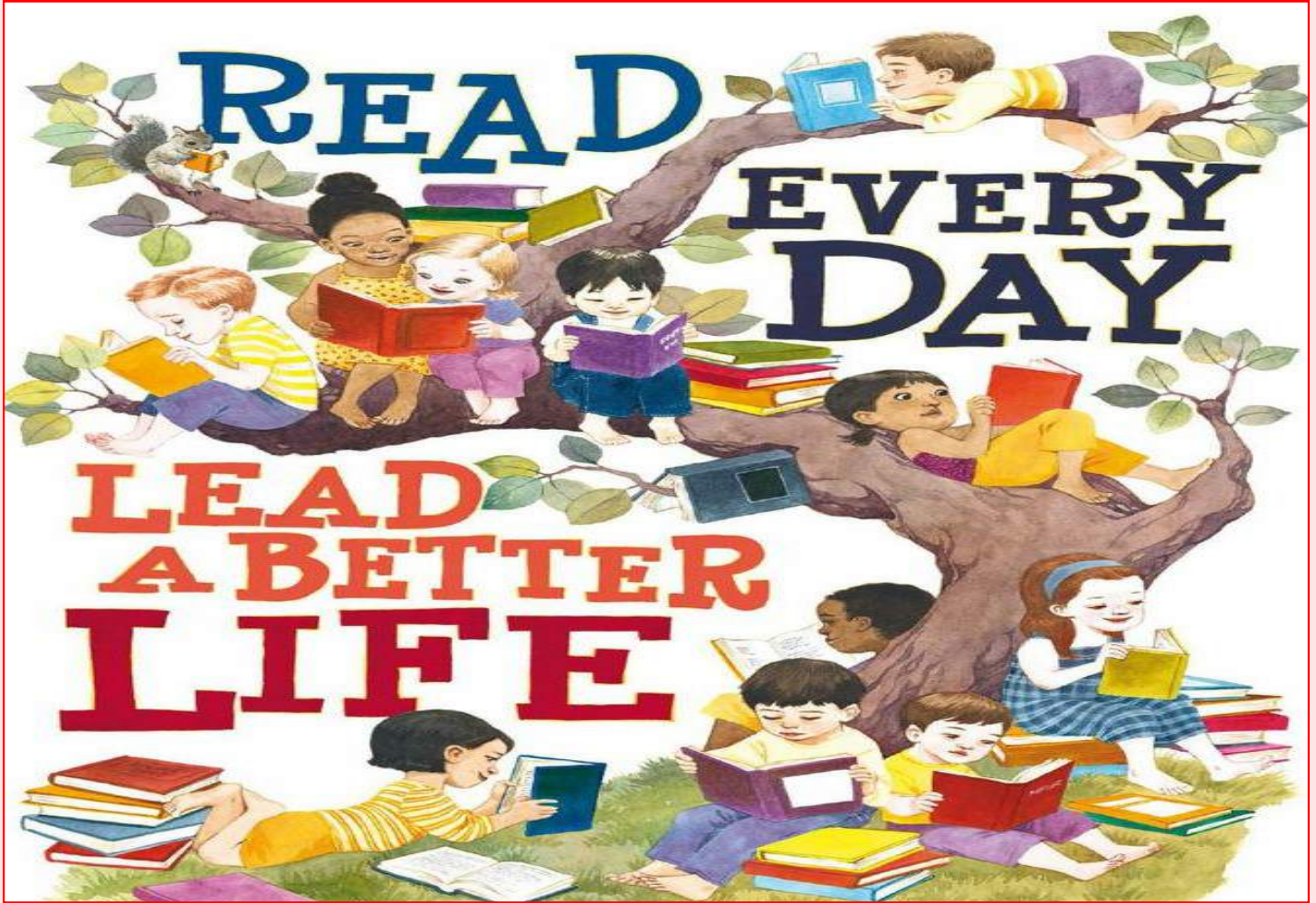

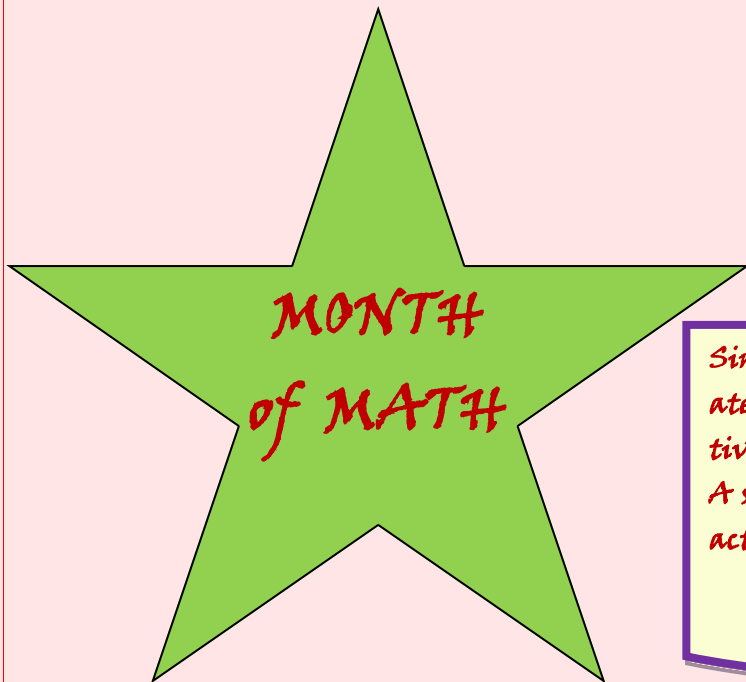
