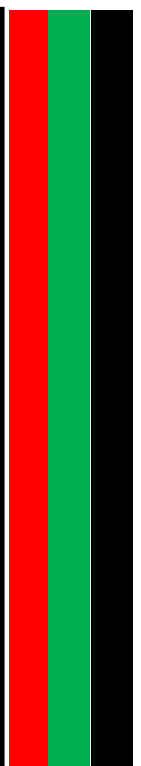
Flag Day Celebration

It was a very well planned and implemented event by the English department. Every English teacher had taken up the responsibility and did justice to every single task in relevance to this event.

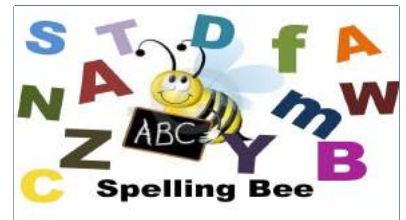
The list of words was shared with the students during the vacations, so that they utilize the holidays to prepare themselves for the competition.

STEAM in Action:

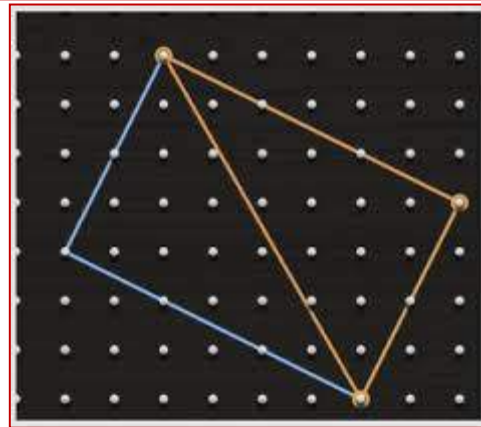
First Lesson/Project The Geo board

A geoboard is a mathematical manipulative used to explore basic concepts in plane geometry such as perimeter, area and the characteristics of triangles and other polygons. It consists of a physical board with a certain number of nails half driven in or push pins, around which are wrapped geo bands that are made of rubber.



Third Law of Motion Balloon Rocket

The mechanical force that pushes a **rocket** or aircraft through the air is known as thrust. In this **experiment**, you'll make a **balloon rocket** that is propelled by pressure. ... The escaping air exerts a force on the **balloon** itself. The **balloon** pushes back in a manner described by Newton's Third Law of Motion



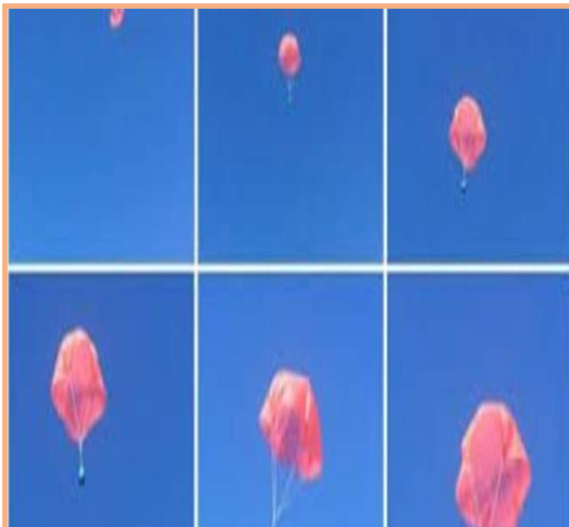


Air Resistance/Gravity

PARACHUTE EGG DROP EXPERIMENT

This fun parachute egg drop experiment is a great demonstration of the forces acting on parachutes. If you drop something it falls to the ground. This is because it is pulled by the gravity of the Earth. You'll notice that some things drop faster than others, this is because of air resistance. Try dropping pieces of papers and a big book. Which drops the fastest?

We are going to try dropping an egg on its own, dropping an egg attached to a parachute and an egg in a plastic bag under a balloon.
