

An individual who masters languages participates effectively and responsibly in a multi-cultural world.




































Hindi Diwas is celebrated on the 14th of September, to commemorate the adoption of Hindi as one of the official language in different Hindi speaking states of India.






















## ACTIVITIES & COMPETITIONS - MONTH OF LANGUAGE

An array of activities and competitions were held to enhance the learning process wherein the students explored new ways to enjoy the language they learn, with fun and frolic.








