CAMPING RULES AND DISCIPLINE

- One of the aims of school camps is for students to learn responsibility for their actions. As camp is considered an extension of the school program, normal school rules apply.
- Camp behaviour expectations will be explained to students on arrival.
- Sound and consistent discipline is the joint responsibility of all students.
- During activities, all students present share the responsibility.
- All activity sessions commence in the Activity Area.
- Please be thoughtful for the rest of your group and ensure you arrive on time for each activity session.
- If you arrive late for the activity, the session may be cut short and people in the group may miss participating in the activity.
- Students should maintain good standards of hygiene and cleanliness.
- Rubbish bins provided should be used to dispose trash.
- Horseplay is not allowed.
- Running is not allowed.
- Do not leave the camp area without teacher's approval
- Clean up your activity area before beginning another
- Do not go into other children's cubbies, backpacks, bags, etc.
- All children will help at clean-up time

Camp Rules when camping outside school:

- Be responsible for belongings
- Always tell a group leader when you check in or out
- Always tell a group leader when you are going to use the bathroom
- Always stay with your group and group leader
- Confine eating to lunch and snack times
- Always be courteous and cooperative
- Foul language or verbal abuse will not be tolerated
- Any form of physical fighting will not be tolerated
- Play safely and use good sportsmanship
- Be quiet during quiet time a good rule is to rest and relax
- Take rules seriously during activity times
- Report anything wrong (e.g., broken toilet, burned out light, etc.) to the group leader
- Leave money and special items (e.g., CDs and Walkman) at home

RULES WHILE ON TRIP

On a trip, participants are to remember

- Children will walk together to the bus/van and wait at the door
- Children will enter the bus/van in an orderly line when the driver or the leader directs them to do so
- Walk only when entering, leaving, or moving through the bus/van
- Hands, books, and personal belongings must stay inside the bus/van
- Nothing shall be put outside the windows of the bus/van
- Windows shall be opened only with the permission of the leader or driver
- The bus/van shall not be littered in any way
- Children must stay with the group at all times
- Children must stay with the adult they are assigned to (usually their team leader) at all times
- Children will be expected to follow the special rules of the site being visited (reviewed before each trip)
- Children will not use bathrooms without leader's approval
- Horseplay and fighting will not be tolerated
- Any child with behavioural problems on a trip may be excluded from the next trip.
