#### Science Exploration in Grade 1!





ed by the English department.




The grade 2 students ac-




#### Hello January!

### DESIGN A BOOK COVER! BLOOMING OUT THE PETALS OF CREATIVITY


In our 'Designing a Book' Cover' activity, students became architects of visual storytelling, breathing life into their written words.






# Story Book Making Activity

Overall, story writing was a holistic educational experience that promoted both academic and life skills.


















# Brochure Making Activity


This activity served as a platform for honing creativity and design skills. Students were tasked with translating complex information into visually appealing and easily understandable content.

Moreover, the collaboration inherent in the brochure-making process has significantly improved teamwork and communication skills among the students.

















# Story Board Making Activity






#### 2D Shapes Posters

The vibrant and informative posters not only demonstrated the students' understanding of geometric concepts but also added a colorful touch to the school environment, fostering a love for learning among peers.







Grade 5 students recently engaged in a vibrant coordinate city activity, where they collaborated to map out and create their own city using coordinates.



This also helps students learn about the three major *types of rocks* (sedimentary, igneous and metamorphic) and how *rocks* are formed.


This activity provide an opportunity for artistic expression by allowing them to design visually appealing posters that effectively communicate information about different types of rocks.
