
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


Spelling Bee Competition






It's a fun learning day for all of us!!!





Measurement





Fraction







Science quiz bee- Quizzes make learning fun! Students participated actively in Quiz bee competition. The quiz consisted of easy, average, and advanced levels.





AJBP conducts Term 1 Virtual Open House



Student Led Conference


What is a student led conference?






January – Science Month Celebration 2020 - 2021

Students led Conference Open—House


