LIYA AJI “SASTRA PRATHIBHA”- 2016

Science India Forum (SIF) is a voluntary organization working in the field of science and technology in collaboration with governmental and non-governmental departments, ministries and institutions. Every year SIF organizes Sastra Prathibha contest examination for students from grade 5 to Grade 12 to make affinity among students towards pure science.

The contest comprises of two tire screening. The first level is a MCQ round held in all schools during the month of November and the second and the final round is a science camp scheduled at a conducive venue decided by the SIF.

Sastra Prathibha contest 2016 had over 27000 students participated in the first round. Liya Aji of Grade

11 AJI was one among the top eighty students qualified for the second round in the contest.



The second round of the Sastra Prathibha Contest was a full day Science Camp at Amity University, Dubai on Saturday, 04 February 2017. Similar to yester years, the SPC Round 2 was conducted in three categories, Sub juniors (Grades: 5, 6 and 7), juniors (Grades: 8, 9 & 10) and seniors (Grades

11 and 12). In each category, candidates had a quiz competition, scientific reasoning test, picture identification round and a question and answer session (viva voce) to assess their general knowledge, subject knowledge, and aptitude, analysis and reasoning abilities

Two top ranking students from each grade at UAE level were selected for the title Sastra Prathibha 2016 and Liya Aji was one among the two to be honored as Sastra Prathibha 2016.

Sastra Prathibhas will be awarded with Certificates and Medals by VijnanaBharati, India in the award ceremony to be held soon. Sastra Prathibhas will get a golden opportunity to visit the primer Research and Development institutes in India and interact with emi-
