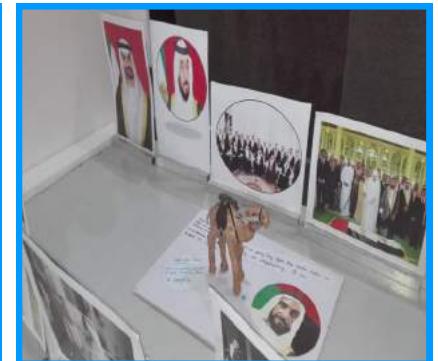
47th UAE NATIONAL DAY CELEBRATION
