WHAT HAS HAPPENED SO FAR?

Academics: We are moving forward with the reaffirmed vision of "nurturing our young people to be achievers of extraordinary determination, who set right goals in areas of education, morality, attitude, and ethics and values.". This year we embarked with measuring of students learning outcomes in relation to Student Competence framework that extends the tradition and strengths of the school and that responds to needs of integrating competences and values into our teaching and learning. Our school curriculum has undergone a number of developments for the upcoming academic year such as introducing new options subjects for IGCSE and AS Levels. This is aimed at providing a holistic curriculum of secondary education to meet the needs of the future. From September, digital resources will be used in all core subjects.

Special groupings have been employed in Languages, Mathematics and other subject areas to cater for the full range of student needs and many teachers have used their spare time to organize make-up lessons and CARE sessions to take care of individual learning needs. Final Report Cards - Grades 1 to 9 and collection of miscellaneous certificates and other documents

As per the Ministry of Education rules (which took effect from 2013) final report cards are issued through **ADEK eSIS** (Enterprise Student Information System) and show an average of all three assessment components of the all three terms for Grades 1 to 8. For grade 9 school-based forecast marks are issued

1. **FIRST TIME ENTRIES** for Subjects for the CIE Examinations for Grades 9 to 11, should submit the Entry form:

First window: on or before 30th June, 2018 Second/Last window: 5th July, 2018

RE-SIT ENTRIES: on or before 7th September, 2018

LATE FEE ENTRIES: between 8th September – 12th September, 2018

VERY LATE FEE ENTRIES between 13th September and 17th September. No re-sit requests will be entertained after 17th September.

- 2. Results of the CIE Examination, May/June 2018, will be available online on 14th August, 2018.
- 3. Login IDs are available at the Student Affairs Office from 18th June, 2018 until 28th June, 2018.

It is extremely important all parents procure the following documents before the school closes:

- 1. Bonafide certificate for the purpose of passport/visa renewal
- 2. T.C. if the student has to leave the country during the summer vacation
- 3. To Confirm the student enrolment for AY 2018-2019:
 - Clear all fee dues (2017-2018)
 - Re-registration fees: to confirm the students enrollment for AY 2018-2019
 - Submit the Updated Emirates ID (EID)

Please note: Any student who has violated the Rules and Regulations of Exam Procedure (FA, ETE, or any other examination will have their assessment results negated and no re-test will be offered.

- Annual fee, books & uniform fee will not be collected from such parents.
- Such students may not be promoted and may be removed from the school with notification to the
 Ministry /ADEK, who will not allow document and fee defaulters to join any other school, until the dues
 are settled in the previous school.

INFORMATION FOR NEW ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-19

School Timings: Grades 1 to 12 - 7:30 a.m. to 1:50 p.m. Kindergarten - 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Bus Transport: If your child is availing the bus transport facility, the school will contact you informing the bus number, driver and the bus supervisor of your child before the start of term.

<u>House Colours:</u> AJB takes many statistics into consideration in determining the house colours of the students. This is in order to keep a proper balance of the numbers of male and female students and their age ranges within the four houses of the school. Therefore, changes in house colours for students will not be entertained.

New Class Lists: The new class lists will be available in school in the first week of September, as parents come to school for the books and uniforms. The class lists are made giving careful consideration to the demographic details, the number of boys and girls in a class (from KG to Gr.12), students' learning styles and learning aptitudes. AJS recruits the best possible teachers after a screening process by the Human Resources and Academic departments and we believe that learning happens through good student centered teaching and not through a preferred teacher. Therefore, we strongly advise you to abstain from making requests for change of sections or specific teachers. The decision of the school will remain final. The school also reserves the right to change a student's section.

<u>Baseline Assessment</u> (for Grades 1 to 12): Students of all Grade levels are required to make a study schedule to revise their topics done in previous grade level for all the Core and compulsory subjects. The Baseline Assessment for the *Primary school* (Grade 1-6) shall take place <u>Tuesday</u>, 4th <u>September to Thursday</u>, 6th <u>September</u>, 2018 while *Secondary School* will have their Baseline Assessments on <u>Sunday</u>, 9th <u>of September to Wednesday</u>, 12th <u>September 2018</u>. These will be part of their formative assessments and impact on forecast grades and will facilitate target setting for students. This good practice will help the students to utilize their summer break in a focused manner and ultimately to do well in their class academically.



Students in some grades will also take the GL CAT4 international benchmarking tests early in Term 1. There is no preparation required for these.

Baseline Assessments should be taken with a serious mind frame to ensure enhancement in individual students' grades and learning targets.
