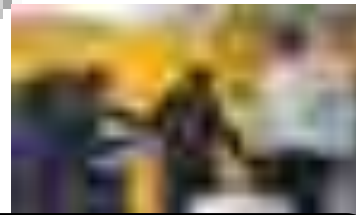
Grade 5 created awareness about child labour with a slogan 'Put me in -class not in glass'' highlighting the fundamental Right-






National Day Celebrations in AJ

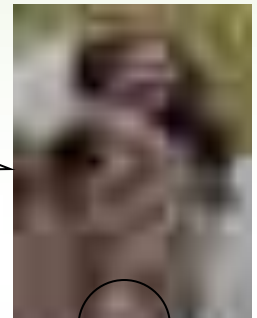

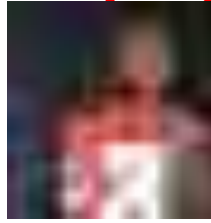


Eco Club Activity:- Tree Plantation Programme
