game. Anyone could sense the aura of competitiveness around the teachers as each team gave their all in each of the games.

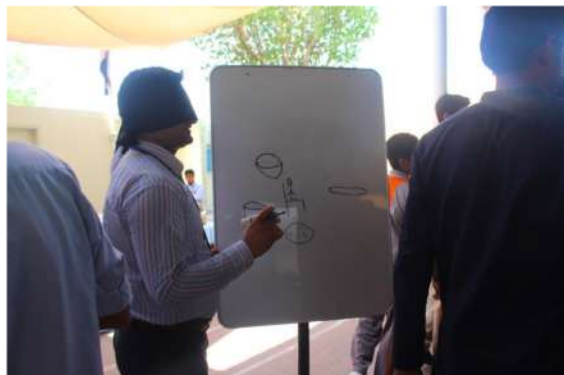
