*We see you as our most constructive reviewers. In turn, my colleagues & I are always on Hand should you require assistance at any time.*

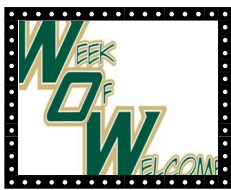

At Alain Juniors, we always try to make teaching and learning fun with lots of classroom activities.

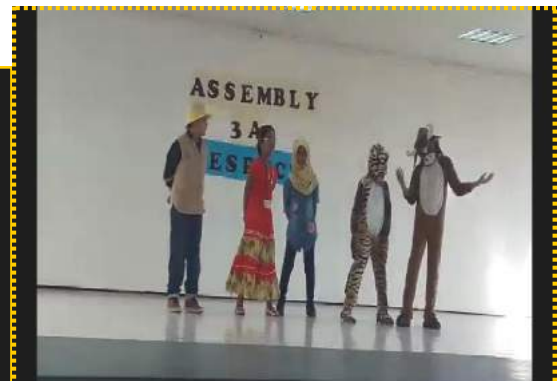


# WEEKLY ASSEMBLY
