



VISITS

Emirates Dates Factory, Al Foah

School organized an Educational Field trip to – Emirates Dates Factory, Al Foah for grade 6 students. The students were able to observe how dates were received, packed and cleaned under hygienic conditions. The students understood that the fruit has sustained generations and has become an integral part of the UAE's heritage and identity. They gained knowledge that there are currently over 44 million date palms in the UAE that can be grouped under 199 different varieties and together produce 76,000 tonnes of fruit every year.
