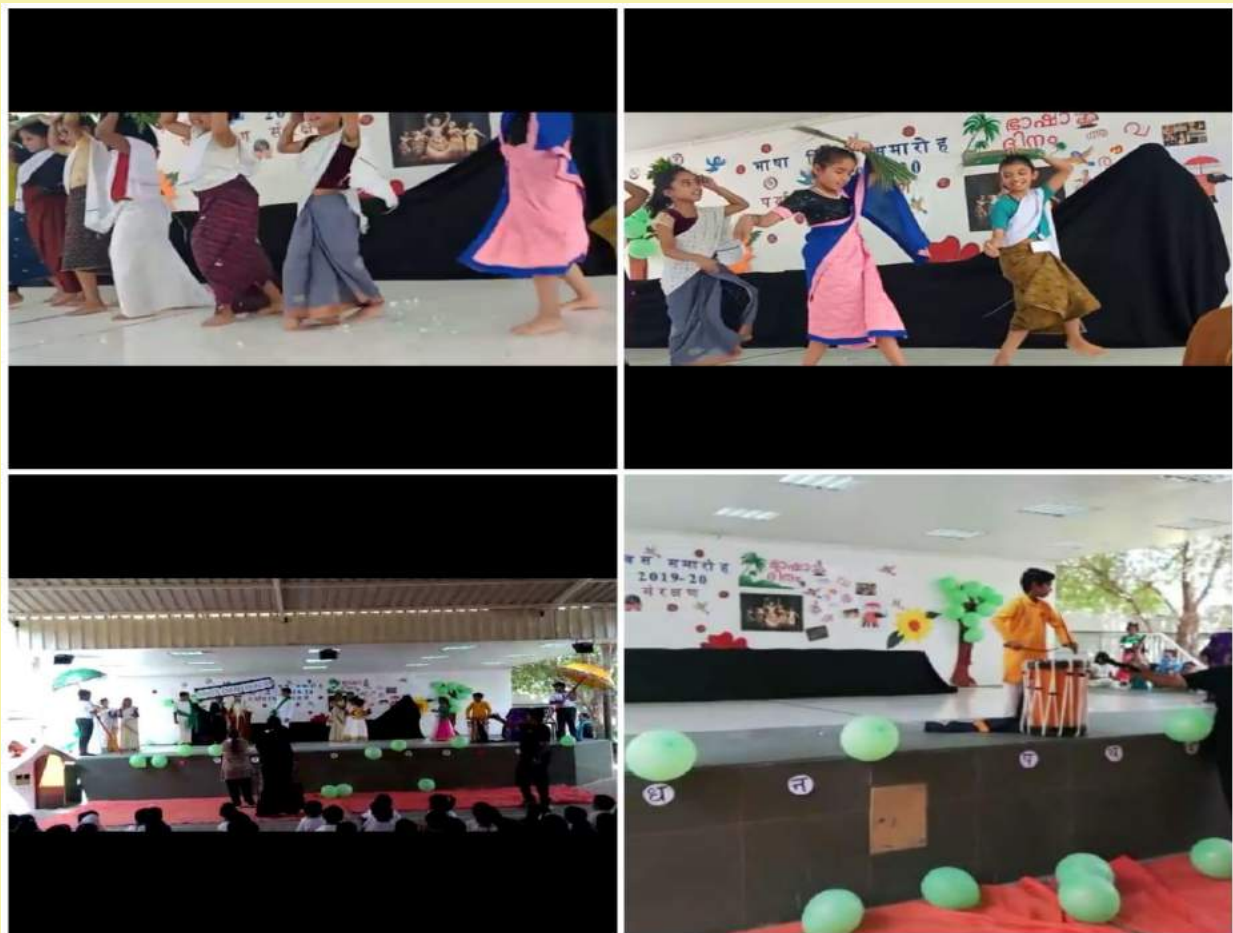


LANGUAGE MONTH ASSEMBLY –MALAYALAM

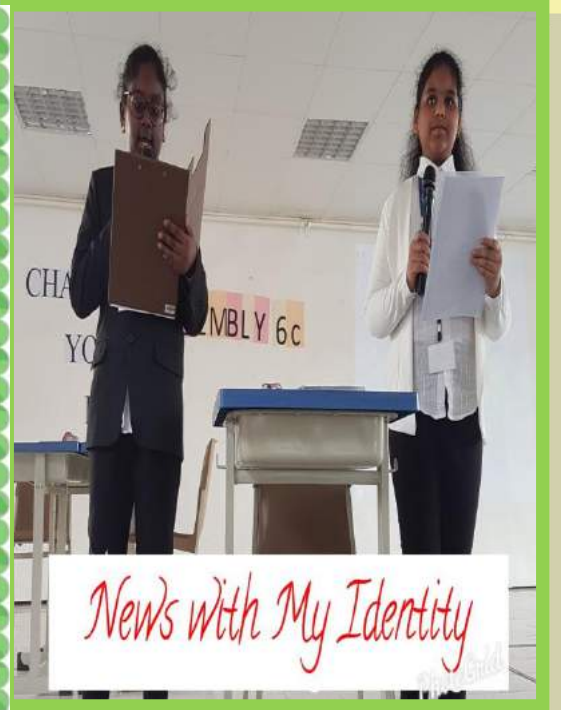
Morning Assembly
