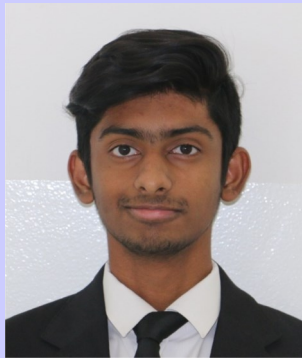
ticipated in the event. Two of our teams emerged as winners. They were 6th place Daniel Biju and team 7th place Lakshmi Vikas
