- Teaching & Learning (KG to Grade 12): Academic year 2020-21 will begin officially on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2020. - <u>Orientation Program</u>: Orientation for the parents to inform about the policies and academic program of the school will be sent to individual e-mails through a power point presentation. This will also be posted on the school website.
- <u>Uniforms:</u> The regular and PE uniform for students of KG to Grade 12 are available at our Sanaiya store. Parents can obtain/purchase them only after restrictions of movement are lifted.

- MOE Books: It is mandatory to buy MOE Books as per the directives from ADEK. The books are:

The payments for these books will be included in new academic year fees and books will be issued/delivered once we receive them from Ministry of Education Book Store.

- MS Teams Student accounts: Kindly note that MS teams account will be disabled during summer break.
- <u>Baseline Assessments (Grades 1 to 12)</u>: Students from Grades 1 to 12 are required to make a study schedule to revise concepts covered in previous grade. The Baseline Assessment will take place during the *Week of welcome/first week* when school reopens in August/September 2020. This will be a part of the formative assessment and will impact the grades of students. This will also facilitate target setting for students. We believe and that this good practice will help students to utilize their summer break in a focused manner and will ultimately help them to do well in their class academically.
