UAE Celebration and Marty's Day

National Day is a designated date throughout the world on which the celebrations mark as the nationhood of a nation. The UAE, United Arab Emirates became independent on 2nd December 1971. At that time six Estates/Emirates united under a Federal Constitution. This is the United Arab Emirates. These six estates' names are Abu Dhabi, Dubai, Sharjah, Ajman, Umm al-Quwain, and Fujairah.

The UAE national day is basically a celebration of the union of the six estates while Ras Al Khaimah joins these six estates on 10th Feb 1972. Now the UAE has a total of seven estates. These seven estates combined to form a worldwide modern country, headed by Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, the federation's first president.

It was 30th of November 2020 Monday Al Ain Junior School KG Department celebrated UAE and Martyr's Day. Students from distance learning and face to face group participated in the said occasions. Many of them wore the UAE dress and others brought some stuff about UAE symbols. Each class had the time to watch the history of UAE.
