1. Mode of learning:

- Authorized Reopening Models by ADEK: Full return, Half Day, Alternating day, Alternating week
- Full Distance Learning for Temporary Closures and Students of any age with medical conditions classified as high risk during the COVID-19 pandemic, and students 16 years of age and above who are unvaccinated. Students of any age opting for voluntary distance learning (only applicable to schools offering a distance learning option).

- **3.** Assessment pattern: As shared during parent orientation once again we would like to share assessment pattern followed in Al Ain Juniors School. Assessment is an integral part of the planning cycle and promotes effective teaching and learning. Assessment is used as a tool to inform planning, track students' progress, and raise standards. Assessments are developed according to two dimensions: Cognitive domain (Knowledge and Understanding, Application & Analysis, Evaluation, Synthesis) and the subject content.
