Safety Guidelines and Protocols for parents and students returning the school premises:

• Access Points – Please note specified gate entries for parents and students below:

Entry/Exit Point	Allocated access to:	
Gate A1 & A5 Parents and visitors only		
Gate A6-B	Bus transport students entry for all levels	
Gate A7	AJB own transport students in all levels entry/exit	

Hand sanitizing gel dispensers shall be installed (preferably contactless) at every access point for obligatory use by every person entering the premises.

- Proper hand hygiene and mask-wearing Masks shall be worn by any individual entering
 the school premises with exemption for KG students, students with medical condition
 (supported by a medical certificate, students of Determination, during lunch and engage in
 high risk sport activities.
- **Personal Hygiene** Students shall be encouraged to always carry a sanitizer with 60%-80% alcohol in their bags to sanitize their hands frequently
- Temperature Screening Non-contact temperature screening shall be held for each person
 when entering the school or taking the bus. Students with temperatures of 37.5 C or higher
 will be screened again with a handheld infrared thermometer and transferred to the
 isolation area upon confirmation of fever for further follow up as per the school incident
 management protocol.
- **Staggered Entry/Exit** Arrival and departure times for each group, alongside the protocol for entering and exiting shall be clearly communicated to parents.
- Accompanying Parents/Guardians Students may be accompanied until the access point (without parents/guardians entering the premises) by a maximum of 1 parent/guardian during drop off or pick up.

- Physical Distancing Schools shall implement the following physical distancing requirements: 1 meter between all individuals (students, staff, visitors) across the, and 2 m between "all-access" staff and others.
- **Bubble Group** Students will be allocated by group/microbubbles by class/section wise and ensure that measures are in place to limit group interaction to contain the spread of COVID-19 should cases arise within a certain group.
