Greetings!

On behalf of the school management of Al Ain Juniors School, I am pleased to inform you about the commencement of registration for the <u>May/June 2022 Series</u> of Cambridge Assessment International Education Examinations. As per our usual practice, here is a number of important information to take note of, with regard to registration procedure as well as standard practices of Cambridge Assessment International Education:

- 1. Registration begins on 5 December, 2022
- 2. Registration windows are as follows:
 - a. 4 December 2021 31 January 2022
 - b. 1 February 2021– 6 February 2022 (late entry)
 - c. 7 February 10 February 2022 (very late entry)
- 3. Entry forms will be sent to each candidate via MS Teams through class teachers.
- 4. All completed registration forms must have the following attached to them:
 - a. 4 Recent passport photos taken in <u>school uniform</u> only
 - b. A valid copy of students' Int'l passport
 - c. A valid copy of students' Emirates ID (front & back)
 - d. A copy of previous CIE certificate or statement of result (if candidate has sat any CIE qualification previously).
- 5. Parents must clear all fee dues, inclusive of the current month in which exam fee is being paid.
- 6. Candidates opting for self-study subjects must notify the examinations officer before entering
- 7. Parents/Guardians must check and sign all forms before returning them to school.
- 8. Name of candidates must appear on the form as they are on the Int'l passport only and this must correspond with previous CIE certificates, if there was any previously obtained.
- 9. The following signatures are required before submission of forms to the front office: Subject teachers', exam officer's & the principal's.
- 10. Fees list will be attached to the entry form.
- 11. Please direct all enquiries to the schools' front office or the examination officer.
- 12. Every prospective candidate will receive a copy of CIE internal policies and guidelines which must be signed and returned to school, without which any candidate can be processed for the registration.
- 13. Compulsory virtual orientation is scheduled for all grade 9 students opting for GCE O Level subjects and 10-12 students along with their parents/guardians on Monday, 29 Nov., 2020 at 5.45pm 7pm prompt. Parents can join the meeting using their children's May/June 2022 CIE MS Teams.

N.B: Kindly be informed that all of the above may be subject to ADEK's regulations with regard to Covid 19.
