





Arabic Calligraphy


Arabic calligraphy is the artistic practice of handwriting and calligraphy based on the Arabic alphabet.


AJI Primary Grade 1 to 6 had a competition in Moral Science to show case the cross curricular link between the subjects.


















Drop Everything And Read

It is said that everything you read fills your head with new bits of information, and you never know when it might come in handy.












The students of AJI were welcomed back to school on 11th April 2021 with positivity, excitement and a whole bunch of interesting activities conducted by the class teachers.








































Garden - Earth Day
