Spelling Bee Competition

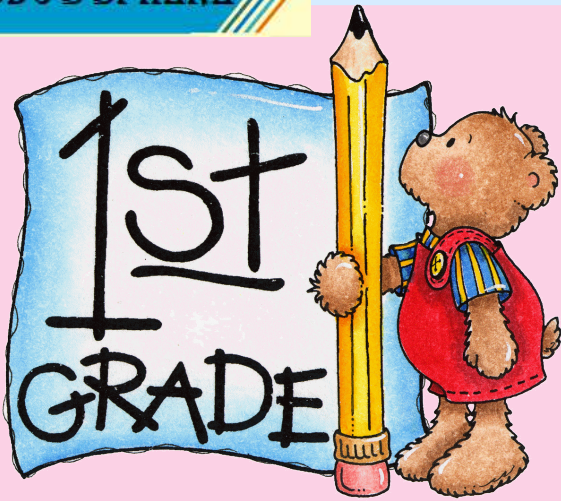

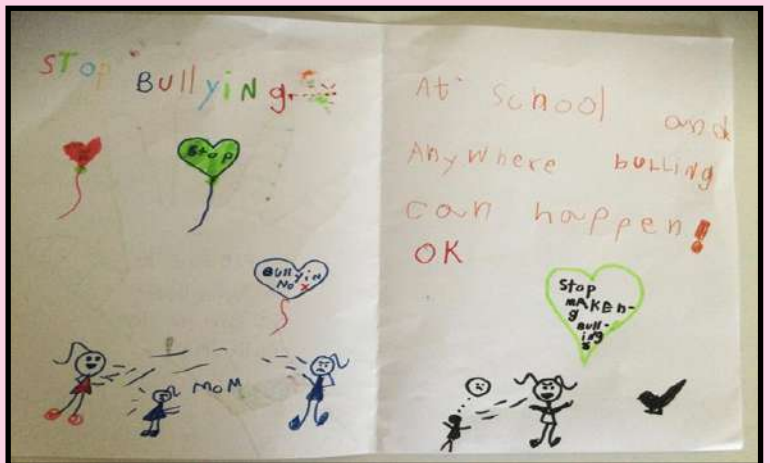

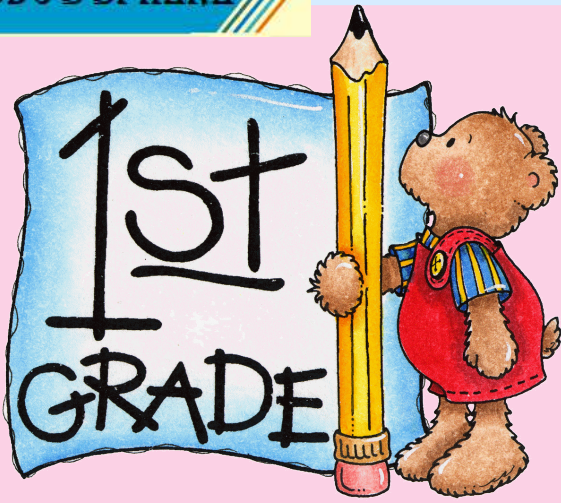
Have you been bullied in school or in social media?

Grade 1 students shared their amazing activities to support the National Anti-Bullying Week campaign.





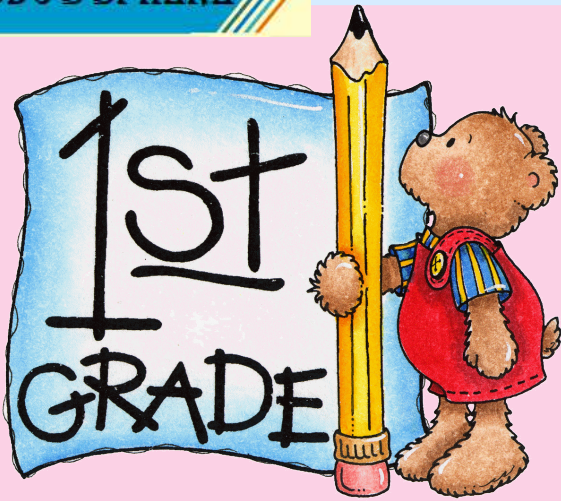

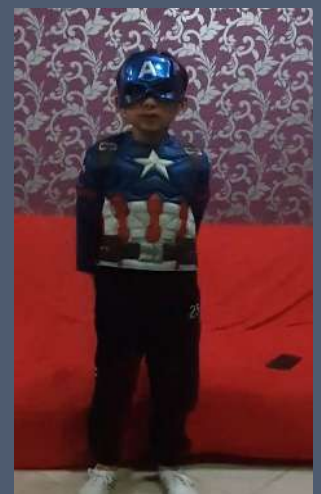
UAE National Day

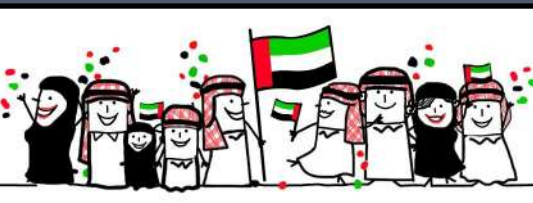


UAE Flag Day

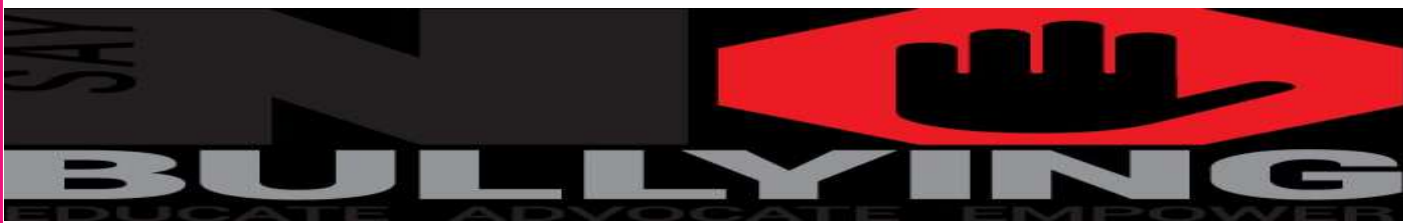

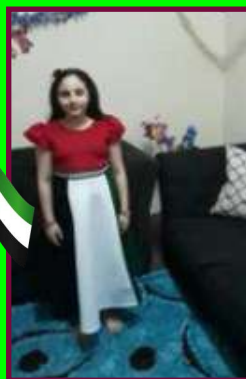

The response was quiet a success as it was daunting task to select the winners for the first round, after an intense deliberation the winners



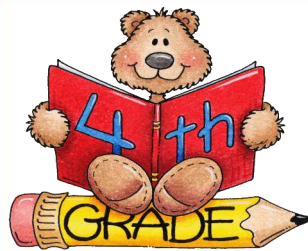

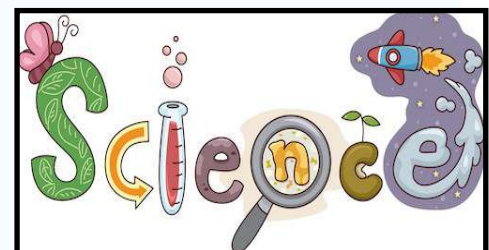
WORLD SCIENCE DAY FOR PEACE AND DEVELOPMENT 2020

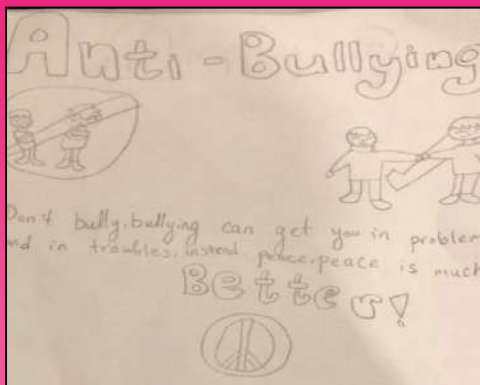
ANTI BULLYING

UNITED UNDER THE UAE FLAG

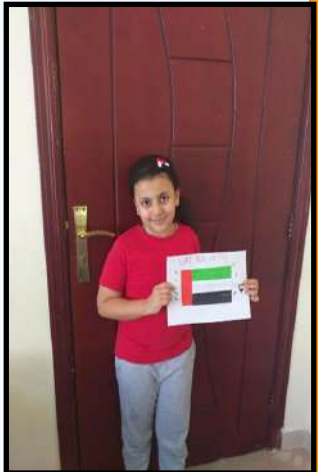

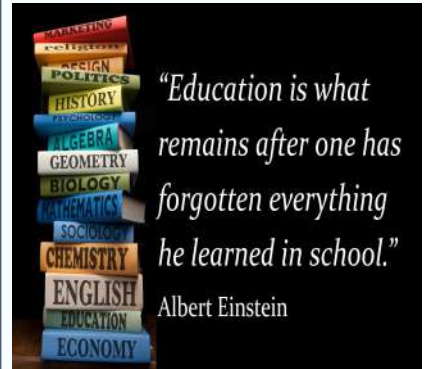

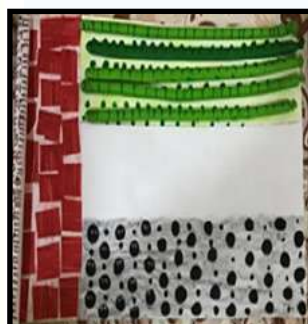

1. UAE Flag Day



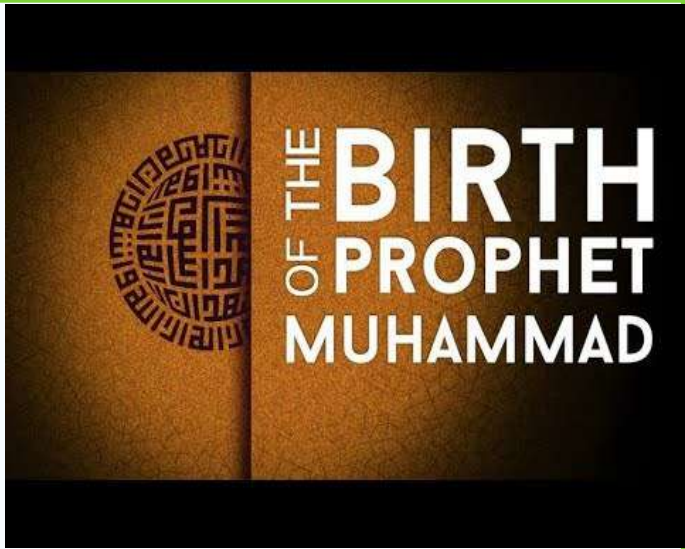

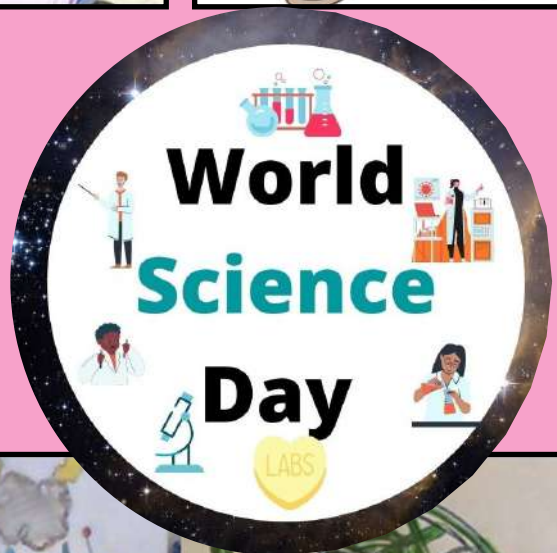
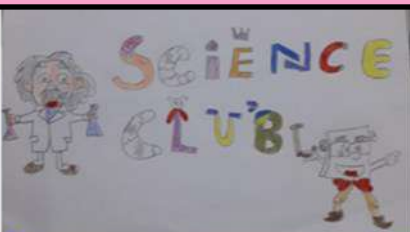


Prophet Mohammed Birthday – Islamic Assembly

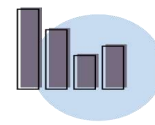

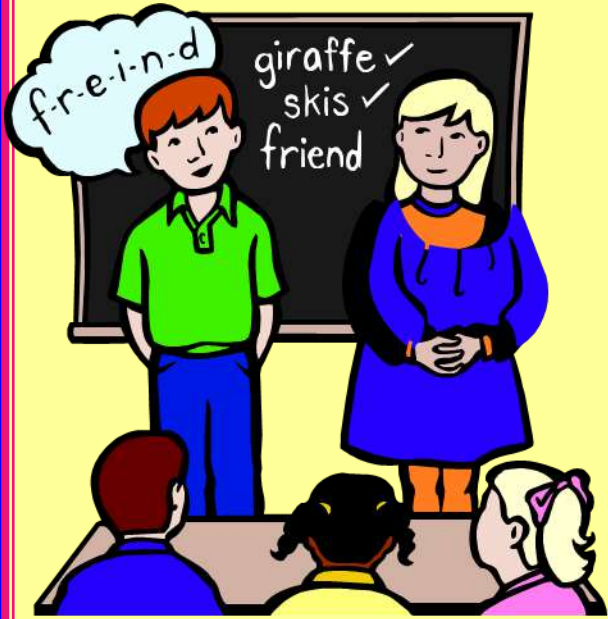

Spelling Bee



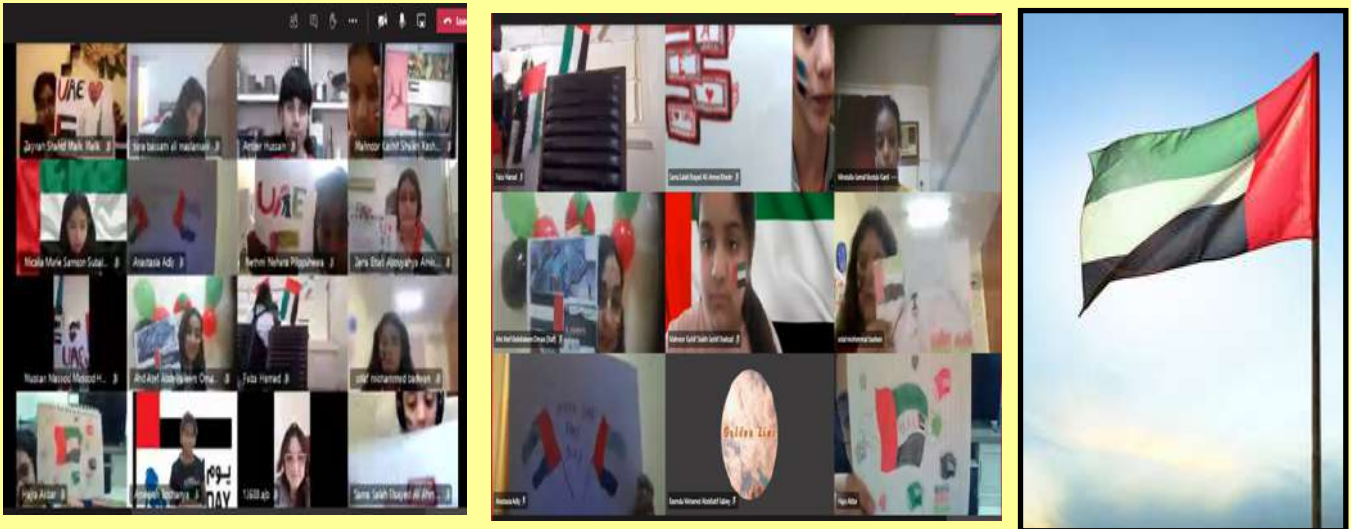
