REOPENING MODEL AND LEARNING MODE FOR TERM 3

Under the guidance of the Abu Dhabi Department of Education and Knowledge (ADEK), we are thrilled to announce the full return to face-to-face learning effective from term 3. Kindly note that as per the guidelines received from ADEK, Distance Learning cannot be offered in the coming term.

REDUCED PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

Distance learning can no longer be offered in the upcoming term <u>except</u> for the categories listed below. This will be coupled with further reduced COVID-19 precautionary measures to support the return to normalcy as the health situation continues to improve.

FIRST ENTRY PCR TEST FOR STUDENTS

- Student must present a 96-hours negative COVID-19 result.
- Students can avail a free PCR test at a private or public clinic, hospital, or drive-through test center without the need to present a designated school code.
- Present the Emirates ID to the testing center (or Passport if their Emirates ID has not yet been issued).
- Parents can contact their preferred center to confirm the availability of a free test.
- Students below the age of 12 and Students of Determination (all ages) can choose to get a saliva test at any of the designated saliva test centers in in Al Ain.

We advise students to test within the below ranges to ensure they get their results in time:

- Students returning on Monday, 11 April 2022 are advised to test from 7 to 9 April 2022.
- Negative PCR result on Al Hosn App is required to show at gate entry.
- Send a copy to your respective Class Teacher (screenshot from Al Hosn App)
