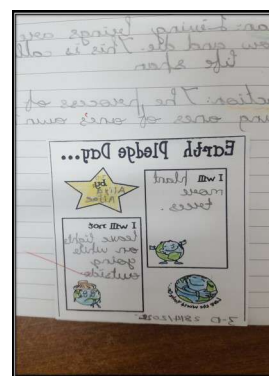
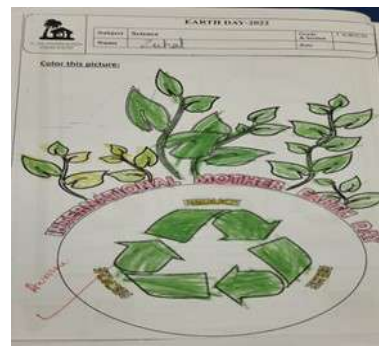
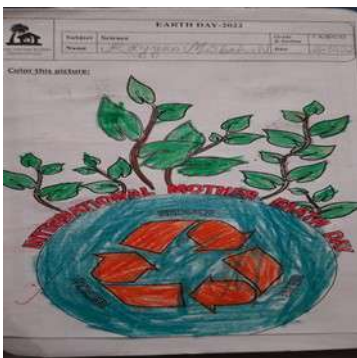


EARTH DAY

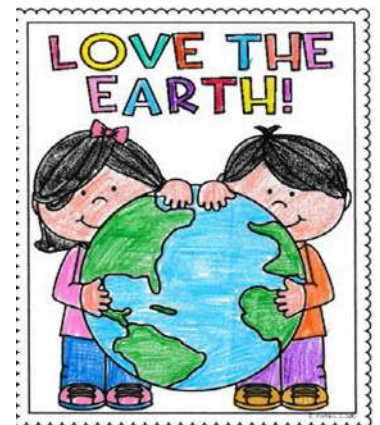
