


<u>Progress in International Reading Literacy Study (PIRLS) 2021</u>

PIRLS assessed the two overarching purposes for reading that account for most of the reading done by young students both in and out of school: for literary experience and to acquire and use information.











Grade 5—Class Activities




Area and perimeter Robots:



GRADE 5D'S ASSEMBLY ON NATIONAL ANTI -BULLYING


