These Bulletin boards were visually appealing interactive As these information and Facts were asked as questions during the Break time Spot prize Quiz.


















FLAG DAY—3rd November

Educational trip to "Traditional Handicrafts Festival -Al Qattara"




Harmony in Diversity - UAE with India
