Market Day












Children had a fun filled experience of selling and buying vegetables and fruits from their peers. They were excited pretending to be vegetable and fruit vendors and buyers.

The enriching experience gave the students an opportunity to showcase not only their proficiency in handling money but also to display their marketing skills.
















English Poem Competition

Islamic Celebration






Arabic Poem Competition
