School Transport Enrollment for AY 2025–2026 (New and Continuing Students)

- In accordance with the revised School Transport Policy, all students—whether currently enrolled or new applicants—are required to reapply for school transport services on an annual basis.
- Application Deadline: **Wednesday, 2nd July 2025**

Please note: Applications received after this date will be considered only if space permits.

➤ **Release of school certificates and other documents**

- Payment invoice, Bonafide certificate or any other certificate for AY 2024-2025 shall be issued **from 18th August 2025** onwards **after the confirmation of re-enrollment** by paying the first installment which includes Re-registration Fee, Tuition fee for August / September 2025, MOE books fee, transport fee (if availing).
- Transfer Certificate (T.C.) for student moving outside Abu Dhabi Emirate, can only be issued **from 18th August 2025**
- IGCSE, AS, and A-Level Certificates will be issued as soon as the school receives the same from the CIE.

Fee Settlement & Payment Instructions

A. Fee Settlement

➤ **Important Notice:**

- To confirm the enrolment for the new academic year 2025/2026, the first instalment must be paid in full, before the first day of school.
- Partial payments are not accepted.
- Failing to confirm the enrolment and clearing the dues before the start of the year, we will be **unable to continue providing tuition & transport services from the first day of school.**

➤ **Payment Window:**

- **Monday, 18th August – Sunday, 24th August 2025**
- *Note: No partial payments will be accepted. Failure to complete re-enrolment will result in suspension of tuition and transport services from the first day of school.*
