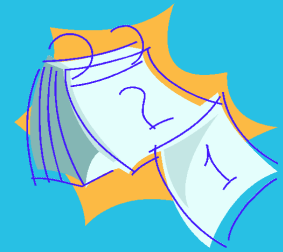

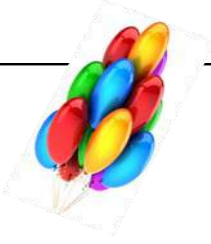




Student Led Conference
