CLOSURE OF SCHOOLS & CONTINUITY OF STUDENT LEARNING

Dear Parent,

We would like to share the following important information with you all which has been designed to minimize the learning gaps that might arise due to the decision of cancellation of Term2: March 2020 for Kindergarten. This decision is made as per the guidelines laid down by ADEK and following the recent announcement of school closures for 4 weeks beginning on Sunday, 8th March 2020 and the activation of remote learning by the UAE Ministry of Education.

- **Spring learning packets:** Learning material covering the subjects Arabic, Literacy, Math, UOW will be shared with you all, so that students will retain the mastery on the acquired knowledge and skills that are essential for future learning.
- **Term 3:** Students to report to school for Term 3 on Monday, 13th April, 2020
- **Means of communication:** We will be adopting following means of communication to reach you all as well as support student learning during these 4 weeks from Sunday, 8th March 2020 to Thursday, 2nd April, 2020

 - Identify a comfortable, quiet space in your home where you can work effectively and successfully.
 - Complete assignments with integrity and academic honesty, doing your best work.
 - Do your best to meet timelines, commitments, and due dates.
- **Guidelines for parents: As a parent or guardian you can support your child to**
 - Establish routines and expectations
 - Define the physical space for your child's study
 - Monitor communications from your children's teachers
 - Begin and end each day with a check-in
 - Take an active role in helping your children process their learning
 - Establish times for quiet work and reflection
 - Encourage physical activity and/or exercise
 - Remain mindful of your child's stress or worry
 - Monitor how much time your child is spending online
 - Keep your children social, but set rules around their social media interactions
