**Teachers are actively using Microsoft Teams; an e-learning platform, disseminating information through videos and online lectures to the students.**

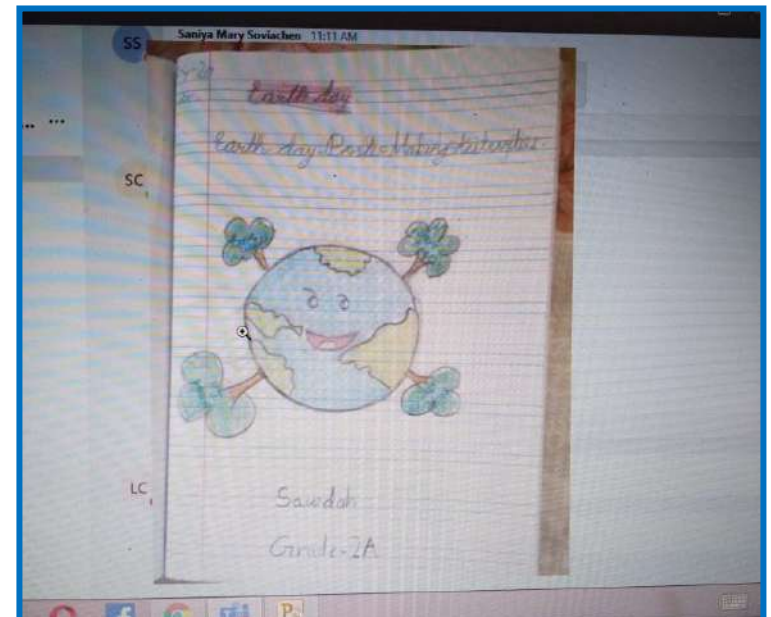
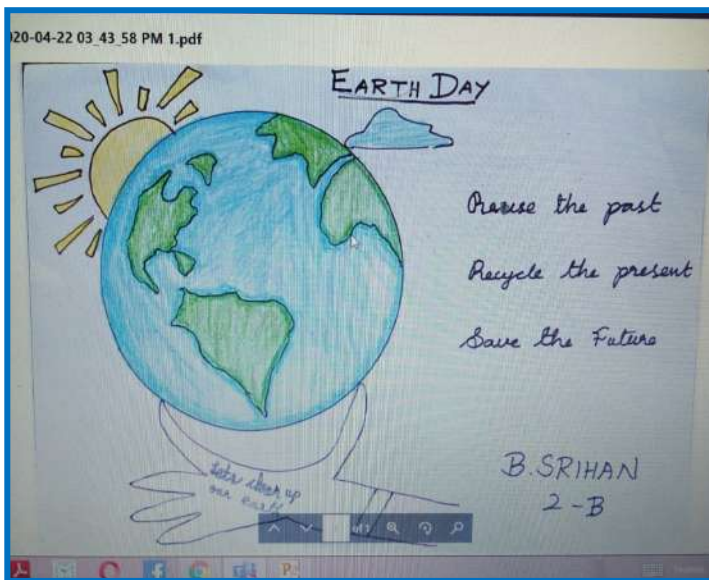

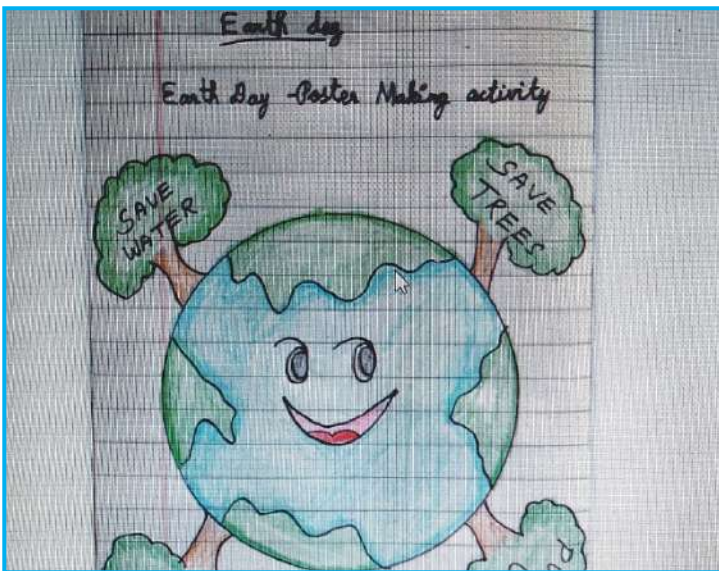
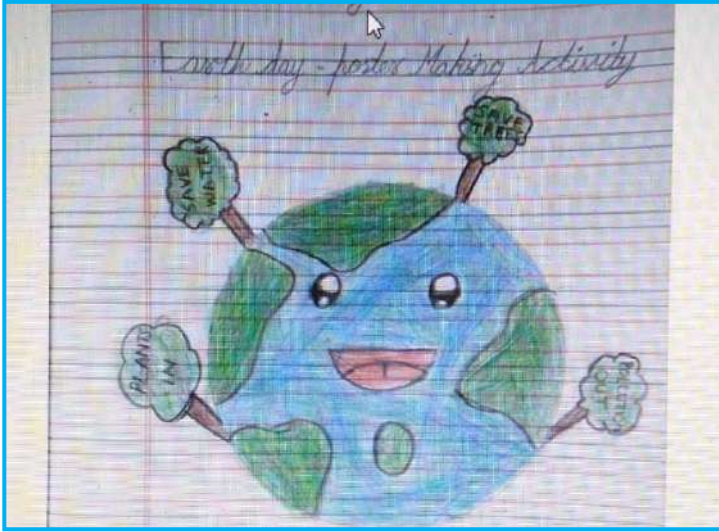
# 50th Earth Day

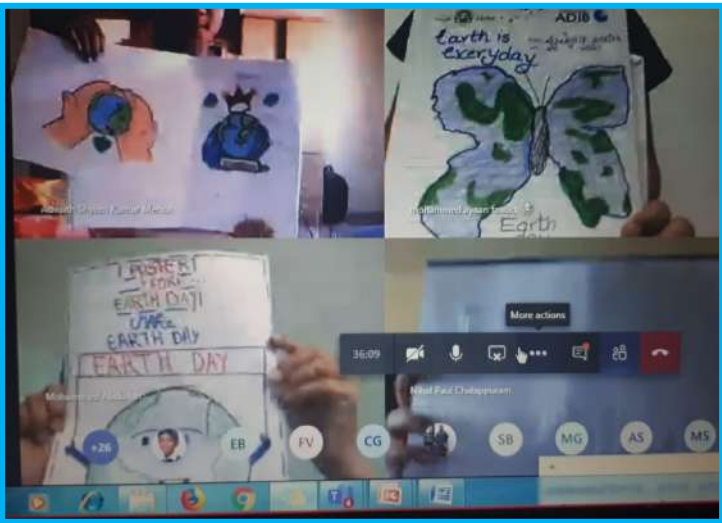
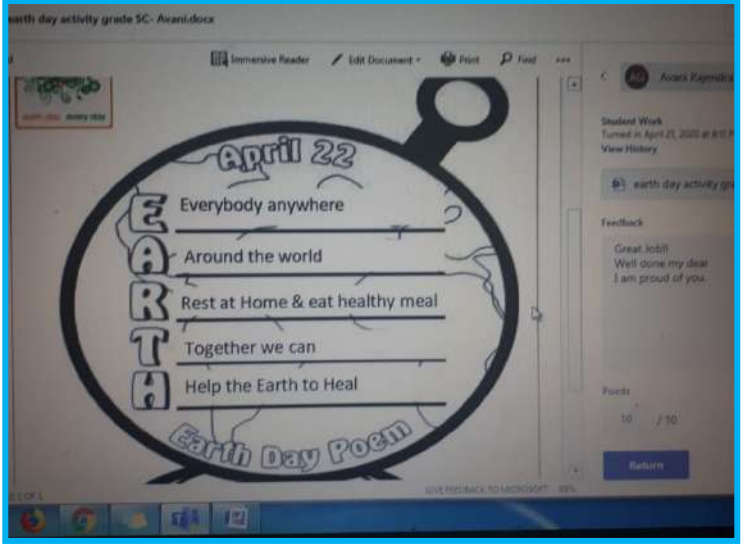
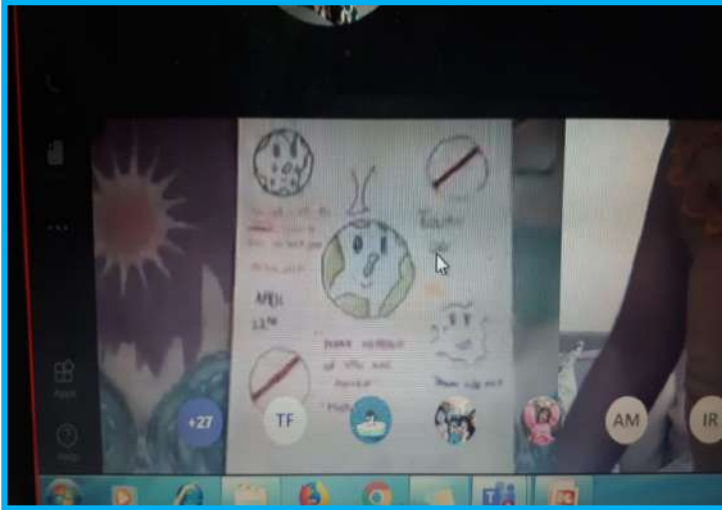
