1. Plant a tree

2. Earth Day Poster Contest

Create a poster that demonstrates the theme "**Together, we can Restore Our Earth**"

- The theme and slogan must appear somewhere on the poster.
- The poster must have some design or artwork depicting the theme or slogan.

3. Day Slogan Contest

Earth Day slogans cover a wide variety of environmental issues. They are not simply limited to "Earth Day" in and of itself. They also apply to environmental and cultural issues. Due to their simplicity and straightforward nature, slogans are an important way to raise awareness of environmental issues on Earth Day. The slogan should be simple and short.

4. Earth Day Poem Contest

Students are invited to submit an original poem related to the environment -- why they care about it, what worries them, what encourages them, what they're doing or anything else related to the Earth.

- Poems must be original (not copied from a book, the Internet or anywhere else) and not previously published.
- Poems can be illustrated, but that is not required.
- Entries will be judged on creativity and form.
- Each poem should have a title.
- Poems should not be longer than 100 words.

To take part on the abovementioned activities, submit by uploading your original content to the Class Teacher on or before 22 April 2021.
