**Table 2: School Entry Requirement**

Category	Routine PCR and Entry Requirement
All students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>96-hour PCR validity required for the first day of physically attending school <u>after main breaks</u> (summer, winter, and spring)</li> </ul>
Students returning from international travel during the academic year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>96-hour PCR validity prior to the first day of physically attending school post-travel* (i.e. 96-hour PCR test is required if a student travelled during the midterm break)</li> <li>Green pass on Al Hosn App</li> </ul>
Students below the age of 16	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>28 days PCR validity</li> </ul>
Students 16 years and above (Vaccinated)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>14 days PCR validity</li> <li>Green Pass on Al Hosn App</li> </ul>
Students 12 years and above Unvaccinated /Incomplete dose of vaccine received	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>7 days PCR validity</li> <li>Green Pass on Al Hosn App</li> </ul>

*\*in adherence to other travel-related requirements*

- Students with signed consent English and Arabic consent forms. Without the signed and printed consent form, the PCR test is not allowed to be administered to the student.
- If a student did not opt the scheduled In-School PCR testing on above mentioned days; then parents can visit any of the designated testing centers or parents can visit any other testing centers at own expense.
- Negative PCR result must be shared with their respective class teachers.
