- **Confirmation of re-enrolment for the new Academic Year 2024/2025**

To confirm the re-enrolment for the new Academic Year 2024/2025 , parents are requested to :

1. Settle all outstanding fees for the Academic Year 2023/2024.
2. For both new and continuing students, parents must pay the first instalment fees before the commencement of the new academic year.



3. First instalment includes
 - Re-registration fee
 - Tuition fee for September 2024
 - MOE books fee
 - Transport fee (if using transport service)

- **Important Notice**
4. the first instalment must be paid in full, (note that from Monday 19 August 2024 To Sunday 25 August 2024 school office remains open) before the first day of school scheduled on Monday 26 August 2024.
5. Partial payments will not be accepted.
6. Failure to confirm the re-enrolment and clear dues before the academic year begins will result in the inability to continue providing tuition and transport services from the first day of school.

- **Mode of Payment**

You can continue to use the following modes of payment:

 - Zenda Application – An intuitive app available for download on Android/iOS. Detailed instructions can be found on our website.
 - Payment at school premises. We accept cash or Credit Card payments.
 - Bank Transfer : If you have an ADCB bank account, you can continue paying the school fee through the 'Direct transfer' Option.

- **New Initiatives:**

We are excited and thrilled to share with you some exciting updates and initiatives that we will be unveiling during upcoming academic year.
