School Timings Update – AY 2025–2026

As we begin the new academic year, we would like to ensure that all parents and students are well-informed about the **school reopening dates and daily schedules**. Maintaining consistent routines and punctuality is essential for supporting student success and smooth school operations.



In line with updated **guidelines from ADEK and M.O.E**, schools have been advised via policy during vacation to review and revise their operational hours for the **Academic Year 2025–2026 to accommodate**. In response, we have carefully reviewed our schedule and will be implementing **revised school timings across all grade levels**, effective **Monday, 1st September 2025**.

The updated schedule has been thoughtfully planned to:

- **Enhance student well-being**
- **Support effective teaching and learning practices**
- **Improve operational efficiency**, including smoother transport flow and reduced congestion
- **Better align with curriculum and instructional time requirements**

To provide adequate time for families to adjust to these changes, the school will **follow the existing (Week 1) timings from 25th to 29th August 2025**. The **new revised timings will come into effect from 1st September 2025**.

🏃 Gate Entry/Exit Guidelines

For KG Students (Gate A8):

- Entry opens at **8:00 a.m.** and closes at **8:25 a.m.**
- Entry requires a **valid Student ID** and **proper school uniform (including jacket)**

For Grades 1–12 (Gate A7):

- Entry opens at **7:00 a.m.**, gate closes at **7:30 a.m.** (no entry after **7:40 a.m.**)
- ID cards and full uniform are mandatory
- Parents/guardians must drop children **at the gate only**
- At pick-up, parents may enter only the **designated waiting areas**
- Please be on time** for pick-up. The school holds **no responsibility** for students outside the stipulated school hours.

◆ Class Allocation:

Classes have been allocated based on demographics, gender balance, learning styles, and academic profiles. **Requests for section changes will not be accepted.**

◆ Punctuality:

Being on time is a core school value. Students who are late more than **3 times** will receive a disciplinary letter. Early pick-up is discouraged as it impacts learning.

◆ Mobile Phones/Gadgets:

Use of mobile phones or personal gadgets is **strictly prohibited**. Confiscated items will only be returned to parents.

◆ School Uniform:

All students must wear the **complete school uniform and ID card daily**.

◆ Baseline Assessments (Grades 1–12):

Students will undergo baseline assessments in core subjects based on the previous year's syllabus. These assessments are part of **formative evaluations** to help set academic goals.

◆ Birthday Celebrations:

- Birthday celebrations are **not allowed**
- KG to Grade 6 students may come in **neat colored dress** on their birthday
- **No food items, sweets, or drinks** are allowed for distribution
