**CBSE Examination Fee Guidelines**

The listed examination fee covers 6 subjects for Grade 10 students

For Grade 12 students, the fee includes 5 subjects

The same fee also covers practical examinations for Grade 12

**Grade 12 Practical Examinations:**

Students must have at least 3 and at most 4 subjects involving practicals

Those taking Mathematics will have 3 practical subjects, while all other students will have 4

**Migration Certificate**

CBSE has stopped providing physical copies of migration certificates

These are available free of charge

Students can download their certificates through the DigiLocker platform

**Refund and Withdrawal Policy**

Once registration is completed, no changes can be made

Students who withdraw after registering will be shown as ABSENT in the school's result records

Examination fees are non-refundable once registration is done.
