❖ **Punctuality**

❖ **Daily School Routine: Arrival to Dismissal**

1. Arrival at School



- Students arrive via school transport or parent drop-off.
- Use only designated gates assigned for each phase/grade.
- Staff will be present to supervise and guide students safely into the campus.

2. Entry into Campus

- Students proceed directly to their designated areas/classrooms.
- Lingering at entry points is not permitted.
- Parents are requested to ensure a quick and smooth drop-off.

3. During School Hours

- Students follow their timetabled classes, engage actively, and adhere to school expectations.
- Full uniform and ID cards must be worn at all times.
- Positive behavior, respect, and responsibility are expected throughout the day.

4. Breaks and Movement

- Break times will be supervised to ensure safety and wellbeing.
- Students must remain within assigned areas and follow instructions from staff.

5. Dismissal Process

- Students will be dismissed in a structured and staggered manner.
- Movement to buses or pick-up points will be supervised by staff.

6. Parent Pick-Up

- Parents must adhere to designated pick-up zones and timings.
- Kindly avoid delays to ensure smooth traffic flow and student safety.
- Students will only be released to authorized guardians.

7. Departure by School Transport

- Bus students will be escorted and monitored during boarding.
- All bus safety protocols must be followed at all times.

8. Safe Return Home

- Parents are requested to ensure that students reach home safely.
- Any concerns regarding transport or dismissal must be communicated to the school promptly.

❖ Reinforcing Expectations

- Face-to-Face attendance, uniform compliance, ID cards, and behavior expectations remain mandatory.
- Students should come prepared daily with all required learning materials.
